Hard-working wagonmasters for the weekend were Ellen & Mick McAuley, Suzy & Craig Barham and Rhonda & David Layman.

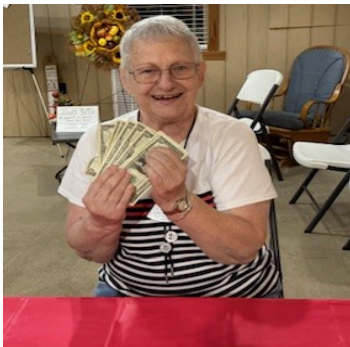


Crafting with Phyllis is a popular thing for the ladies to get together and enjoy. This month we worked on a fall theme.

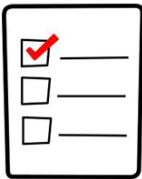

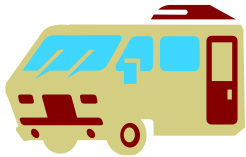
